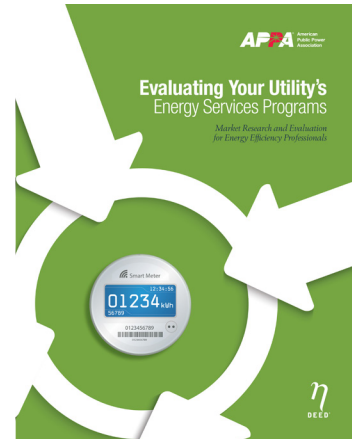


eReliability Tracker

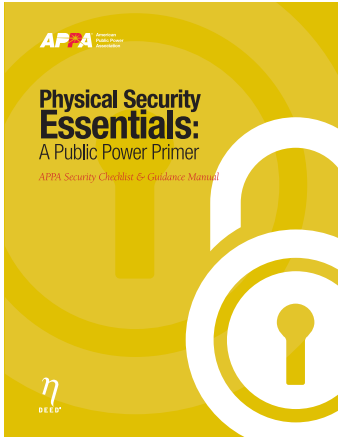


Evaluating Your Utility's Energy Services Programs

This guidebook presents comprehensive step-by-step plans for evaluating energy efficiency and demand response programs. It focuses on small utilities that have limited staff responsible for these evaluations, outsource this process to contractors, coordinate through joint action agencies, or participate in evaluation programs that involve investor-owned utilities or other service providers. It also focuses on how to conduct the evaluation with limited financial resources.

The publication provides links to evaluation materials and uses case studies for step-by-step examples. Substantially revised from the Association’s 2009 publication on this topic, *Evaluating Your Utility’s Energy Services Programs* was written by DNV GL with support from DEED grant.

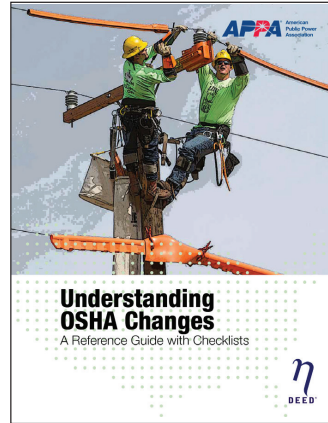


Physical Security Essentials: A Public Power Primer
